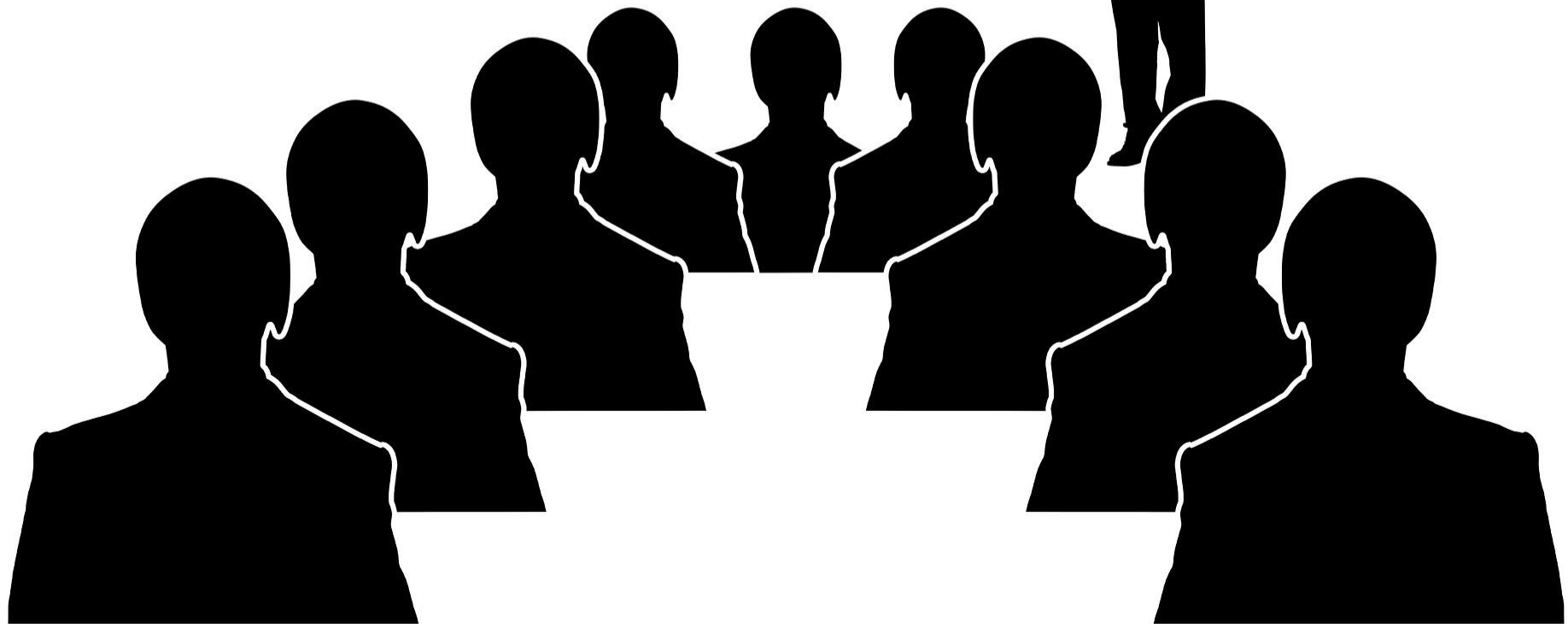

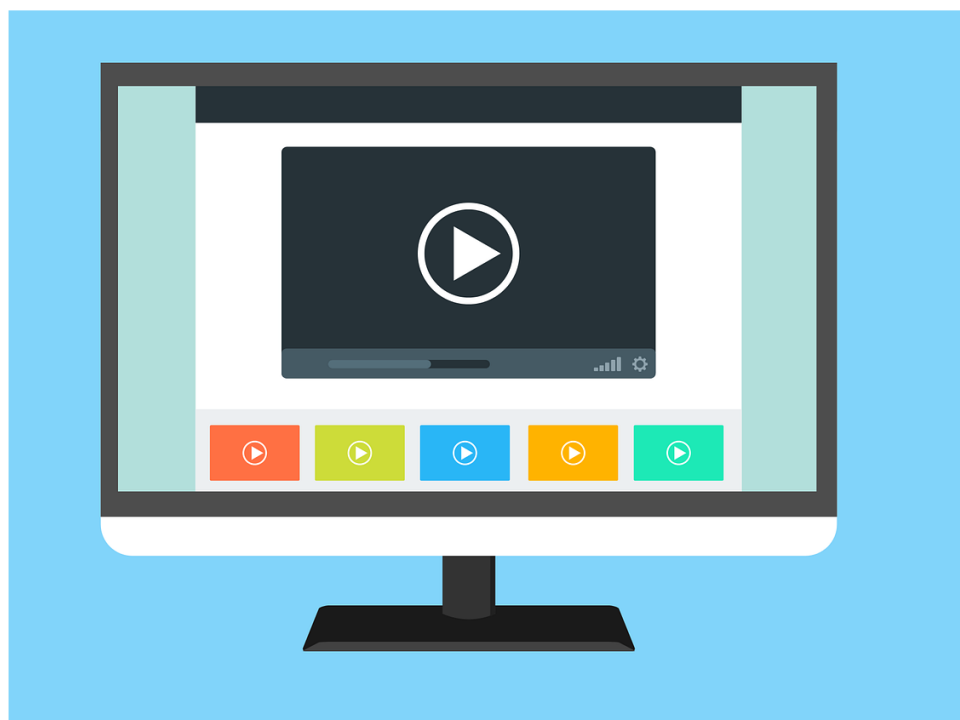

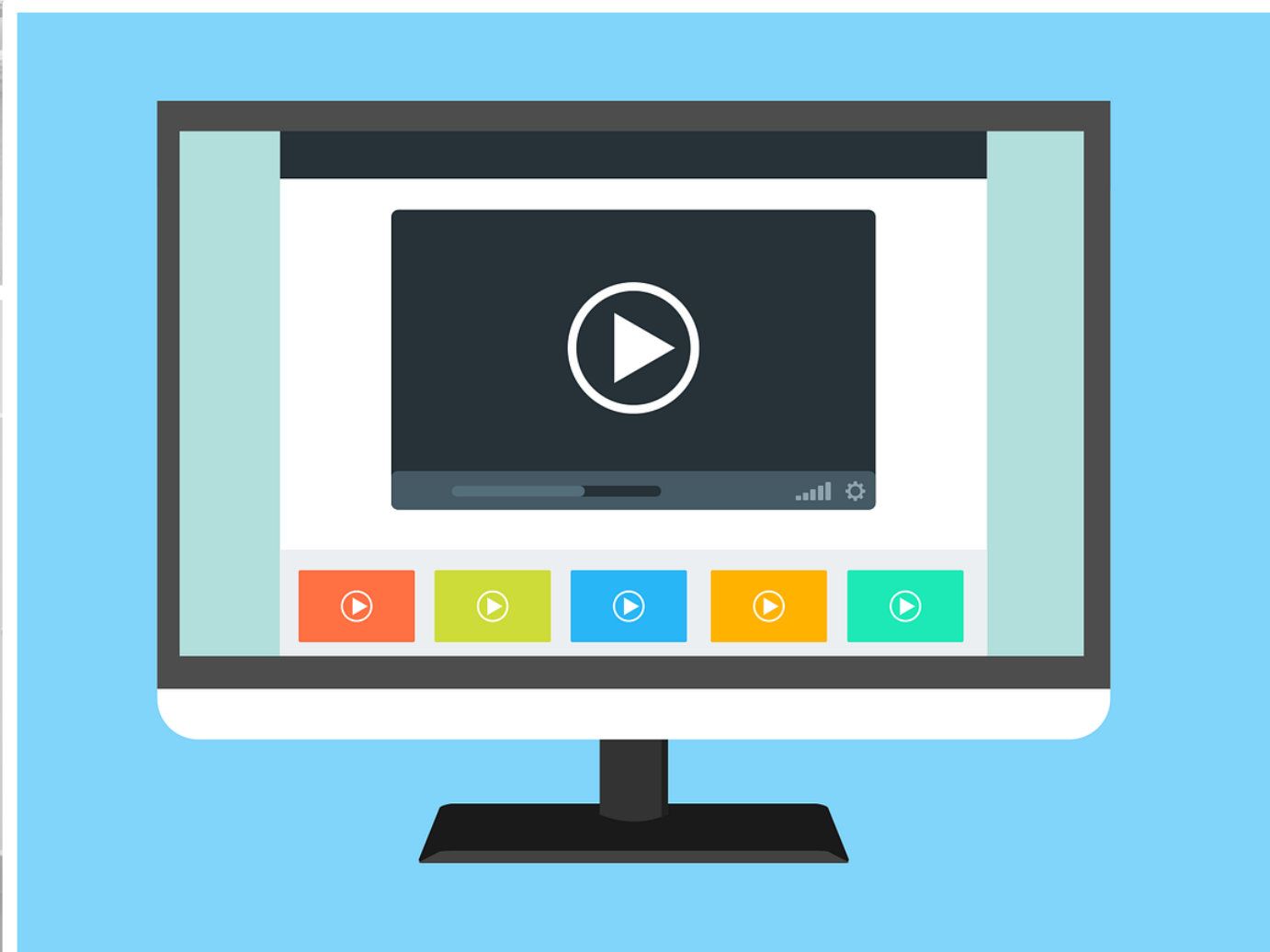

# Using case studies in training

- Objective?
- Length, one part – several parts
- Real or made up?
- Possible topics:
  - definition of trafficking (is this a case of trafficking?)
  - actors/stakeholders (who are they, what are their responsibilities?)
  - Cooperation (who, when, how, why...?)
  - ...



# Why evaluate? (Guide p. 34)

- understand the impact of your training
- learn about factors that lead to success and failure
- know *what* is working and know *why* things are working
- identify room for improvement and adapt your training if necessary
- establish good practices for the future
- track progress
- learn about unintended consequences and outcomes (positive or negative)
- provide for accountability to stakeholders
- make results visible and enable you to communicate the value of your work
