- Victim's Centered Approach with entitled "Potential VoT Rights" Art 11, 12, 14, 17
- Directive 2011/36/EU reflection period etc.

(EU Directive (2004/81/EG), Dublin- Convention)

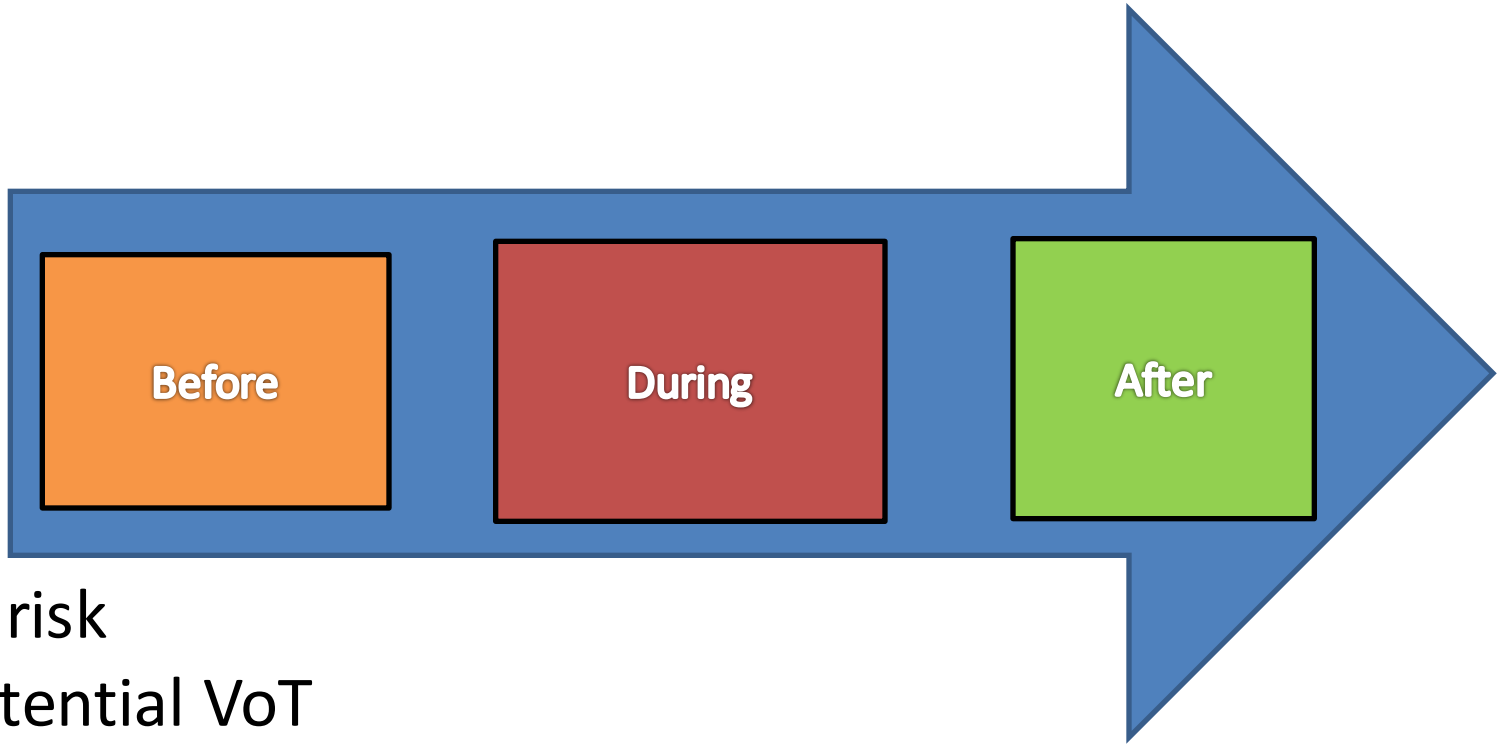


CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

Freedom from exploitation (1989)
 - Art 1, 2, 3, 8, 11, 12, 19, 35, 36, 39
- Additional protocols (2000) on Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEB)
- COE's Lanzarote Convention (2013)

Who need to know the rights?

WHEN IDENTIFIED (according to NRM)

- Service provider
- Law enforcement authorities

IN REALITY

- The victim (!!!!!)

NEEDED

- A broader mandate for First Responers to act (NGOs, churches etc)



A NATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM

-set up by the The Swedish Civil Society
Platform on THB

a pilot program on VoT human rights and support

1. 30 days "defacto reflection-period"
2. specific basic support
3. 60 days (re)integration-support
4. 90 days (re)integration-support
